A. Frederick County Executive, Mrs. Jan Gardner:

As County Executive Jan Gardner was absent, no report was given.

C. Fire & Rescue Division Director, Chief Tom Coe

Additional Services

Engine staffing during the day at Guardian Hose and Walkersville Fire Station, conversion to 24 hour staffing of the fire engine at Libertytown and a tanker driver at Spring Ridge. All services went into effect last month without incident. Thanks to Guardian Hose and Walkersville for welcoming us into their stations.

Recruit Class 28

Currently has 21 members. A graduation/release ceremony will be held on September 25th. By their graduation, we will realize a second ambulance during the day at the Westview Fire Station and a 24-hour second ambulance in Brunswick.

Recruit Class 29

Final selection will be made on September 29th. Class is slated to start on January 4th with 30 members.

MDT Replacement

Continue to replace MDT's. Project is about three-quarters done. Process is going smoothly.

Testing

Ladder testing is underway. Hose testing starts in two weeks.

Northgate Fire Station

Construction bids by multiple vendors have been received. A selection committee, led by DPW, is convening to select a final vendor.

COVID-19

Continue to monitor PPE levels and communicate with all personnel to ensure PPE compliance. Working with Emergency Management, Division of Public Works and Frederick County Health Department on a warehousing project.

Unit Citation

This Friday, DFRS will be recognizing units from Stations 1 & 4 with a Unit Citation for their efforts during an apartment fire in June. The presentation will take place at Station 1.

Grants

Still awaiting word on the award of the pending SAFER and Assistance to Firefighters Grants.

Flu Vaccinations

Will begin flu vaccinations for all emergency responders around the end of September or beginning of October.

Retirements

The end of September marks the retirement of two long-standing DFRS employees. Captain Kathleen Harne and Firefighter Michael Scott Smith. Congratulations!

D. President, FCVFRA, Alan Hurley:

President Hurley stated that he did not have anything to report for the September meeting.

E. Local #3666, President, Stephen Jones:

VIII. COMMITTEE REPORTS

A. Volunteer Fire and Rescue Association, Director, Kevin Fox:

Operations Committee

The Operations Committee met on August 18th. The committee approved the draft Incident Command and Fire Incident Reporting System policies. As well as apparatus standards modifications which were recommended by the VFRA Standards Committee. The next meeting will be held on October 20th at Company 24. This will be an All Chiefs meeting.

CARES Act Program

The reimbursement process continues. The County Finance Division has contracted with a third party auditor to review reimbursement requests to ensure appropriate documentation and adherence to program.

FY 21 July submissions (12 of 25 companies participated), with reimbursements totaling \$103K.

Funding Matrix System

Internal Audit and a third-party vendor are working on the evaluation. Hope to have a draft version by the end of September.

County Finance Regulation Workgroup

A new 7 person workgroup which includes FCVFRA Budget Chair, Angie Fogle from Finance Division, DC Leatherman from DFRS Finance and Administration, FRAB Battalion 5 Representative Frank Davis, Treasurers Matt Elden (Co. 4), John Main (Co.23). This group is working on recommendations for modification to the County Appropriation section of this document. Several companies have been requesting changes to usages as service model has changed from home based response to in station.

ImageTrend

Continue to transfer information to the membership database. Working through the “kinks”. If you experience issues, please reach out to us.

Compliance Training

Training to be completed by October 31st.

PPE Voucher Program

To date, we have used 15 of the 100 vouchers and 7 companies have participated.

A. Old Business

Accreditation Update

Program was re-instituted on August 18th. The initial peer team meeting occurred on September 3rd. To date we have 12 fully accredited, 2 conditionally, 1 in a warning status and one book that still needs to be evaluated. Awaiting 9 others. Hope to have a final report on October 12th.

Board Appointments

The re-appointment of Todd Johnson as Battalion 1 Representative and George Lane as Career Firefighter/Medic Representative have been approved by the County Executive and confirmed by the County Council. Their appointments will extend through June 30, 2023.

B. New Business

Policy 1.05.01 Fire Incident Reporting Requirements

Policy directs responders on when and how to fill out the appropriate report. Policy went into effect on September 1, 2020.

Policy 5.00.25 Incident Command Policy

This new policy was drafted by joint group of volunteer and career responders. Correction to page 9, to reflect 30 minutes instead of 15 minutes.

Question Asked: “This would not be applicable for a response on either Ft. Detrick or Camp David, is that correct?”

Chief Coe replied: This policy as it stands would only be in effect within Frederick County proper, not the two Federal installations.

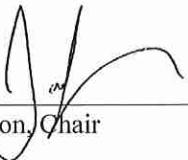
XI. CLOSING COMMENTS
