- III. The guest speaker was Cody Rosenbarker, program manager for Frederick Community College's Student Affairs Initiatives. The office supports the *Making our Spaces an Inclusive Community* – MOSAIC Center. The center celebrates diversity, addresses inequity, and promotes inclusion.
