i. **Director of Volunteer Fire & Rescue**

Planning Workgroup

Work-Based Learning Internship Program

The program begins on August 21st and is open to all volunteer members. Currently, we have 13 high school students enrolled for the 2024-2025 school year. Family Night for new students and their families will be held on August 15th.

Recruitment & Retention

- GEAR UP Class 24-4 began July 23rd with 12 students.
- In the process of developing an in-station mentorship program, which will assign a point of contact at each station to assist with GEAR UP. This program aims to pair trained, experienced volunteers with our newest members.
- Frederick County will host the SAFER Retention and Recruitment Officer Course at the PSTF on October 26-27. This two-day workshop focuses on improving processes from the initial volunteer inquiry through application, acceptance, and onboarding. Registration is now open.

Special Events

- IAP Emergency planning for Gran Fondo Maryland- Sunday September 15, 2024, under development.
- The Great Frederick Fair IAP is currently being developed in collaboration with Emergency Management and the Sheriff's Office. A meeting is scheduled for August 29th. T-shirts have been ordered, and scheduling is underway.

Training

- The MFRI fall 2024 class schedule is now available at MFRI.org, and registration is open.
- For those certified as Emergency Medical Responders (EMR) who need a refresher, they can enroll in the EMT refresher class and take the EMR exam. We aim to offer the EMR refresher class at least once a year, though it often faces challenges due to low enrollment.
- The MFRI survey for spring 2025 classes will be released sometime in August. It is crucial for departments to respond to this survey, as it helps us determine the classes needed.
- Numerous online, no-cost classes are available at USFA.FEMA.gov, including ICS 300 and 400. However, please note that these are refresher courses and do not meet the Volunteer Rank Structure requirements. Additional no-cost online classes, including ICS 100, 200, 700, and 800, can be found at training.fema.gov under the Independent Study tab.
- The MSFA Zembower Training Award for this year was presented to New Market, with Independent Hose as the first runner-up and United Steam as the second runner-up, recognizing excellence statewide.
