Data Discussion and Strategic Planning – Pat Rosensteel led workgroups in a data dive for the IECC Strategic Plan

ACEs Update: Pilar Olivo

ACEs workgroup presented to FMH leadership team on 8/9. Presented action plans for 1-3 year period – a lot of interest and enthusiasm and they endorsed plans and want to play an active role specifically to community education – FMH will secure CEU’s to providers, will offer space, and will support maternal child health work with support group; ACEs workgroup is planning trip to NC to a universal home visiting group and FMH is doing health care provider survey. They are interested in implementing ACEs screening with employee family practice physicians.

Cathy N – increased seats for full day Pre – K from 60 – 180 – some are grant funded through Kirwan, some through the Pre-K expansion grant – N. Frederick, Hillcrest, Emmitsburg, Monocacy, Lincoln, Butterfly Ridge, Tuscarora, Waverly Have identified 4 new schools for next year – Kirwan will fund based on the number from this year.
