### Approval of Open Meeting Minutes - December 21, 2016

#### Status of Assignments

#### CLA:

Capital Improvements Project – Ms. Griffis said the planning phase is complete and the report was finalized. She said the testing phase is underway and meetings were scheduled with DUSWM and DPW and they have started putting together sample populations.

Hotel Rental Tax – Ms. Griffis said she spoke with CLA on completing this audit once again and she will begin to put together a draft task order for the IIAA approval. She indicated the timing of this audit to be around April.

#### SC&H:

ECC Staffing - Ms. Griffis said this audit is complete and the report is included in the packet for IIAA approval.

Mr. Shaun Jones made a motion to approve and issue Audit FCG-16-09, Frederick County Government Emergency Communications Center Program Assessment and publish to the website, seconded by Mr. Bud Otis. All those present were in favor. The motion passes.

PII Planning Phase Audits (FCG, FCC, FCPS) - Ms. Griffis said the County PII Audit Planning Phase is complete and she has a copy which she just reviewed yesterday. She said it is not ready for IIAA approval at this time, but will be ready for a vote at next month's meeting. Ms. Griffis said the FCC PII Audit Planning Phase is just about complete and said that all surveys and interviews have been completed. She said SC&H will now be drafting the same report for FCC. Ms. Griffis said the FCPS PII Planning Phase will kick off on Friday

Water & Sewer Billing System/Processes – Ms. Griffis said the task order has been drafted and is included in the packet along with SC&H's response. She said the task order is ready for IIAA review and approval.

Mr. David Bufter made a motion to approve Task Order FCG-17-05, Frederick County Government Water and Sewer Billings and to issue to SC&H, seconded by Ms. Colleen Cusimano. All those present were in favor. The motion passes.
