# III. Program Status Reports

#### A. IPP

### B. Critical Farms

Staff reported that the next cycle will likely be Spring or early Summer of 2019, after paybacks for the FY19 MALPF cycle are received.

#### C. MARBIDCO Next Generation

Staff reported that there will be a mini-cycle for the MARBIDCO Next Generation program, with an application deadline of November 15.

## D. Rural Legacy

Staff reported that two offers have already been made and accepted for the FY19 grant round and staff are working on making offers to spend the rest of the FY19 funding.

## E. Other Violation Updates

Staff reported that the violation on the Pearre Road MALPF easement property continues, but is on the road to compliance.
