Frederick County General Boards and Commissions

The Frederick County Executive is soliciting applications from interested persons to fill vacancies on several boards and commissions. For more detailed information about these boards and commissions visit www.frederickcountymd.gov/boards.

Adult Public Guardianship Review Board - seeking persons to fill these categories: nonprofit social services professional; psychiatrist; person with a disability; professional in the field of disabilities; lawyer; general public (at-large); and registered nurse, physician's assistant, nurse practitioner or physician who is not a psychiatrist.

Advisory Plumbing Board - a general public (at-large) representative.

Affordable Housing Council - general public (at-large); nonprofit; private industry; and housing consumer representatives.

Agricultural Preservation Advisory Board - a general public (at-large) representative.

Agricultural Reconciliation Committee - seeking agribusiness and civic/homeowners association representatives.

Agriculture Business Council - full-time farmers and producers; and general public (at-large) representative with experience and expertise in agriculture.

Behavioral Health Advisory Council - seeking behavioral health professionals who are not physicians; individuals who are currently receiving or who have in the past received behavioral health services; parents or other relatives of adults with behavioral health disorders; parents or other relatives of children or adolescents with emotional, behavioral, or mental health disorders the onset of which occurred during childhood or adolescence; a clergy representative; and a general public (at-large) representative.

Board of Gaming Appeals - general public (at-large) representatives.

Commission For Women - seeking persons with marketing, legislative or community outreach experience. Must be registered voter and resident of Frederick County.

Commission on Disabilities - general public (at-large) representatives.

Containment Laboratory Community Advisory Committee - general public (at-large) representatives (two to serve as alternates); and a private-sector life sciences industry representative. Must be registered voter and resident of Frederick County.

Domestic Violence Coordinating Council - seeking an attorney with experience representing criminal defendants of domestic violence charges; a member of the public with a demonstrated interest in domestic violence issues, with preference for a survivor of domestic violence; an attorney with experience representing victims of domestic violence; and a high school or college student with a demonstrated interest in addressing domestic and dating violence and resides in the county.

Electrical Board - seeking master electricians; and a general public (at-large) representative.

Equity and Inclusion Commission - seeking a representative of a locally owned minority business; a representative from a local Asian American serving organization; a local African American serving organization; and an at-large member who has shown a commitment to diversity and inclusion within the County. Must be registered voter and resident of Frederick County.

Fire and Rescue Advisory Board - seeking a general public representative. Preference may be given to a qualified applicant who is a resident of the City of Frederick. Interested persons must **not** be affiliated with the fire and rescue service in any way, so they may purely represent the consumers' perspective regarding fire and rescue services. Must be registered voter and resident of Frederick County.

Historic Preservation Commission - seeking individuals that have experience in history, architecture, archeology or related disciplines.

Human Relations Commission - general public (at-large) representatives.

Immigrant Affairs Commission - immigrant residing in the county who is not a representative of an organization; representative of the business community who is an immigrant; an attorney with experience in immigration law; representative of a faith-based organization who is an immigrant; and a student member with a demonstrated interest in immigrant affairs. The student member must be a high school or college student who resides in the County when initially appointed. Must be registered voter and resident of Frederick County with the exception of the student member.

Local Management Board – seeking persons who are interested in bringing together the community and local agencies to address the needs of children, youth, and families. Board members range from county and community agency representatives, parents, and business leaders. Must be registered voter and resident of Frederick County.

Parks and Recreation Commission - general public (at-large) representatives; preference may be given to those who reside in the Adamstown, Brunswick, Thurmont, Urbana, and Walkersville Planning Regions. Must be registered voter and resident of Frederick County.

Public Library Board - seeking general public representatives (one person to serve a 5-year term and one person to fill a two-year unexpired term). Looking for persons who are interested in the libraries in Frederick County and are willing to make a commitment to help guide the growth and development of the library system as the county continues to grow.

This is a working board dedicated to making the community aware of the strengths of the library system. Must be resident of Frederick County

Senior Services Advisory Board - general public (at-large) representative, as well as providers (as defined in the Board's bylaws), to help address and resolve the problems facing the aging population of Frederick County; preference may be given to those who reside in Frederick County Council District 1. Must be registered voter and resident of Frederick County.

Social Services Advisory Board - persons who are interested in supporting the mission and activities of the Frederick County Department of Social Services (DSS) which helps residents achieve safety, independence, and self-sufficiency. Representatives of business, nonprofit, religious, education and community organizations as well as former customers, service providers or contractors who have accessed or provided services through/to the DSS.

Solid Waste Advisory Committee - seeking persons to fill these categories: commercial solid waste/recycling company; business / commercial-retail; environmental group; business/high tech/financial; civic organization; and general public (at-large).

Sustainability Commission - individuals who have a professional affiliation with, or expertise in, one or more of the following areas: agriculture/food security; sustainable land use and transportation; open space and land preservation; green building practices; air quality/climate; water quality; recycling/waste reduction; environmental justice; education; small and/or local business; green jobs/workforce training; human/environmental health; energy; community, grass-roots environmental efforts; finance and governance; diversity, equity and inclusion. Must be registered voter and resident of Frederick County.

Sustainable Monocacy Commission - seeking the following: an individual having educational expertise or experience in the fields of biology, ecology, chemistry, earth sciences, environmental education, natural resources, or related fields; a general public (at-large) representative; and an individual who does not reside on property contiguous to the Monocacy River. Must be registered voter and resident of Frederick County.

Transportation Services Advisory Council - seeking business and general public (at-large) representatives.

Workforce Development Board - seeking Frederick County business representatives. Must either live or work in Frederick County.

The Commission publishes advisory opinions on the Ethics Law and the Public Ethics Law and administers the application of these laws to Frederick County officials and employees, and others who are subject to the laws' provisions. The Commission also decides complaints alleging violation of the Ethics Law and exercises responsibility for enforcement of the lobbying provisions in the Ethics Law and the Public Ethics Law. The Commission meets on the second Wednesday of each month during the evening, as needed.

Other Qualifications and Requirements include:

- Ability to understand and apply the Ethics Law, including the lobbying provisions in the Ethics Law, and the Public Ethics Law to a variety of factual situations;
- General familiarity with the structure and work of the county government; and
- Understanding of general ethical principles applicable to governmental entities.
