

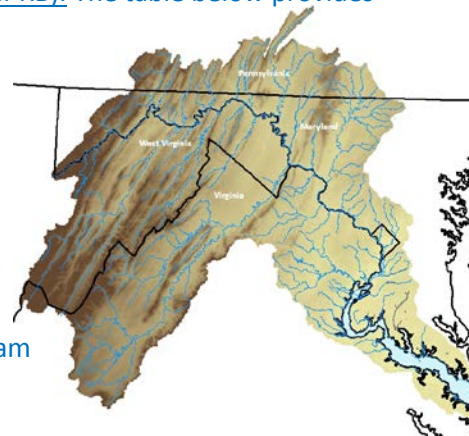
## Interstate Notification & Travel Time Estimates for Spills in the Potomac River Basin

**When a spill occurs in the Potomac River basin that may impact drinking water intakes** contact the appropriate state and/or regional response agency and the Interstate Commission on the Potomac River Basin (ICPRB). The table below provides primary contact information for the agencies in the basin.

When reporting a spill to ICPRB, please provide the following information:

1. Name and telephone number;
2. location of spill, including a) name of affected stream and b) street address and/or latitude and longitude;
3. identity of spill material; and
4. estimated quantity of material spilled (total mass or volume or discharge rate).

When ICPRB receives information on a spill, staff will estimate travel times to downstream intakes using contaminant transport models. This information will be provided to downstream water utilities and other local, state, regional, and federal agencies.
