The County Council of Frederick County, Maryland, finds it necessary and appropriate to amend the County Code to provide that the County Council may not consider an application for zoning map amendment or floating zone reclassification during the time six months before and three months after the general election for Council Members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT IN ENACTED, that the Frederick County Code be, and it is hereby, amended as shown on the attached Exhibit 1.

Add new subsection 1-19-3.110.2.(E):

(E) The County Council may not consider an application for individual zoning map amendment or floating zone reclassification during the time six months before the general election for County Council Members and ending three months after this election.
