



KEG REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Please be aware of Maryland state keg registration laws and follow them.

- The license holder, before making any keg sale to a consumer, must record and keep the following information on the State-approved Keg Registration Form that are designed to affix to the keg:
 - Name and address of the license establishment and a registration number
 - The date of the sale
 - The name, address and birth date of the purchaser
 - The type of identification furnished by the purchaser
- Sellers must place the registration form on each keg when sold.
- The Keg Registration Forms must be kept for not less than 30 days from the date of purchase.
- The forms must be available for inspection by our Liquor Board Inspectors and any other law enforcement agencies during normal business hours.
- The registration form should be removed by the license holder upon the keg's return and the date noted on the copy that is kept on file by the license holder.
- A keg is a container, 4 gallons or more, designed to dispense alcohol directly from the container in an off premise location.
