# OPEN ENROLLMENT STARTS OCTOBER 29TH!

Annual Open Enrollment will be from **October 29, 2018 through November 16, 2018**. Any benefit changes made during open enrollment will be effective on January 1, 2019. Frederick County Government offers its Retirees this annual opportunity to enroll in, cancel, or make changes to their benefit plans.

Retirees will receive communication about the various benefits plans, including any changes for 2019. This information will be mailed to home addresses from The Division of Human Resources. The information and postings on the Retiree Health and Dental Information page of the Frederick County Government website will also be updated to include materials for the open enrollment season.

Retirees are also encouraged to attend one of two informational meetings that are scheduled during the open enrollment period. Representatives from the County's benefit vendors will be at each meeting to present and answer questions.
