County Announces Temporary Road Closure of Foxcroft Drive

FREDERICK, MD – The Frederick County Division of Public Works, Traffic and Permit Section, announced today that Foxcroft Drive between New Design Road and Burning Bush Drive will be closed due to water valve work on Monday, Oct. 28, 2019, beginning at 10 p.m. This closure will allow the Division of Utilities and Solid Waste Management to make repairs. The road will be reopened to traffic early on the morning of Tuesday, Oct. 29, 2019.

Crestwood Middle School operations will not be impacted by this closure.

Motorists are advised to use New Design Road, Crestwood Boulevard and Burning Bush Drive to reach their destinations for the duration of the closure.

The worksite will have a temporary crushed stone surface until final paving can be installed. The paving work will require a temporary lane closure, but motorists will be able to use the road while work is underway with minor delays. This work will not affect Crestwood Middle School operations. This work is anticipated to be completed on or before Nov. 8, 2019.
