Frederick County Government Offices to Be Closed for Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Holiday

FREDERICK, MD – Frederick County Government offices will be closed on Monday, Jan. 20, for the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., holiday. Offices will return to regularly scheduled hours on Tuesday, Jan. 21.
