The Census is Easy, Safe and Confidential.

The 2020 Census will collect basic information about the people living in your household and whether you own or rent. Your answers are private, confidential, and protected by law.

Responding is essential to keeping important services like Emergency Services and Medicare funded for you and other older adults in Frederick County.

IMPORTANT NOTE

The Census Bureau WILL NOT ask for any of the following information:

- Social Security numbers
- Bank or credit card account numbers
- Money or donations
- Immigration status
- Anything on behalf of a political party

**\$11,000,000
LOST**

Due to undercounts in the 2010 Census, Frederick County lost over eleven million dollars!

For each person that is not counted, our community loses \$18,000/person over the next ten years to invest into emergency services, libraries, improving our local infrastructure and other important community programs and services.

By completing the census, you ensure that Frederick County receives the support we need to ensure that you and our entire community can thrive.
