RE: FALL 2015 WATER AND SEWER AMENDMENTS - CASE #WS-15-13

RECITALS

Pursuant to the authority contained in §9-503 of the Environment Article of the Maryland Code, the governing body of Frederick County, Maryland, has the authority to approve or deny amendments to the Frederick County Water and Sewerage Plan ("W/S Plan") after a duly advertised public hearing.


Case #WS-15-13 proposes text amendments to Chapter 1 (Policies and Procedures) and Chapter 4 (Sewerage Systems) of the W/S Plan to establish a Sewer Service Area for the Lewistown Community to address a public health issue, and to apply sewer classifications to properties within the Lewistown Sewer Service Area.

The County Council of Frederick County, Maryland, held a duly advertised public hearing on the proposed changes on April 5, 2016, at which time the public had the opportunity to comment.


