FREDERICK COUNTY REDISTRICTING COMMISSION NEWS

The Frederick County Redistricting Commission will conduct a virtual public hearing on Thursday, October 21, 2021, at 7:00 p.m. to consider a recommendation to the County Council of suggested changes to Frederick County Council district boundaries in order to guarantee uniform voter representation through equal, or equivalent, population counts. The Frederick County Charter requires a Redistricting Commission to review the Council Districts after each decennial census.

PROPOSED CHANGES

The Board proposes moving Precinct 08-001 (Libertytown) with population size of 2,600 and Precinct 19-001 (Unionville/Linganore Grange Hall) with a population of 1,830 from Council District 2 and into Council District 5.

The disparity of population between District 2 and District 5 are outlined below along with the proposed change of moving Precincts 18-001 and 19-001 from District 2 to District 5. Please see the new proposed map below.

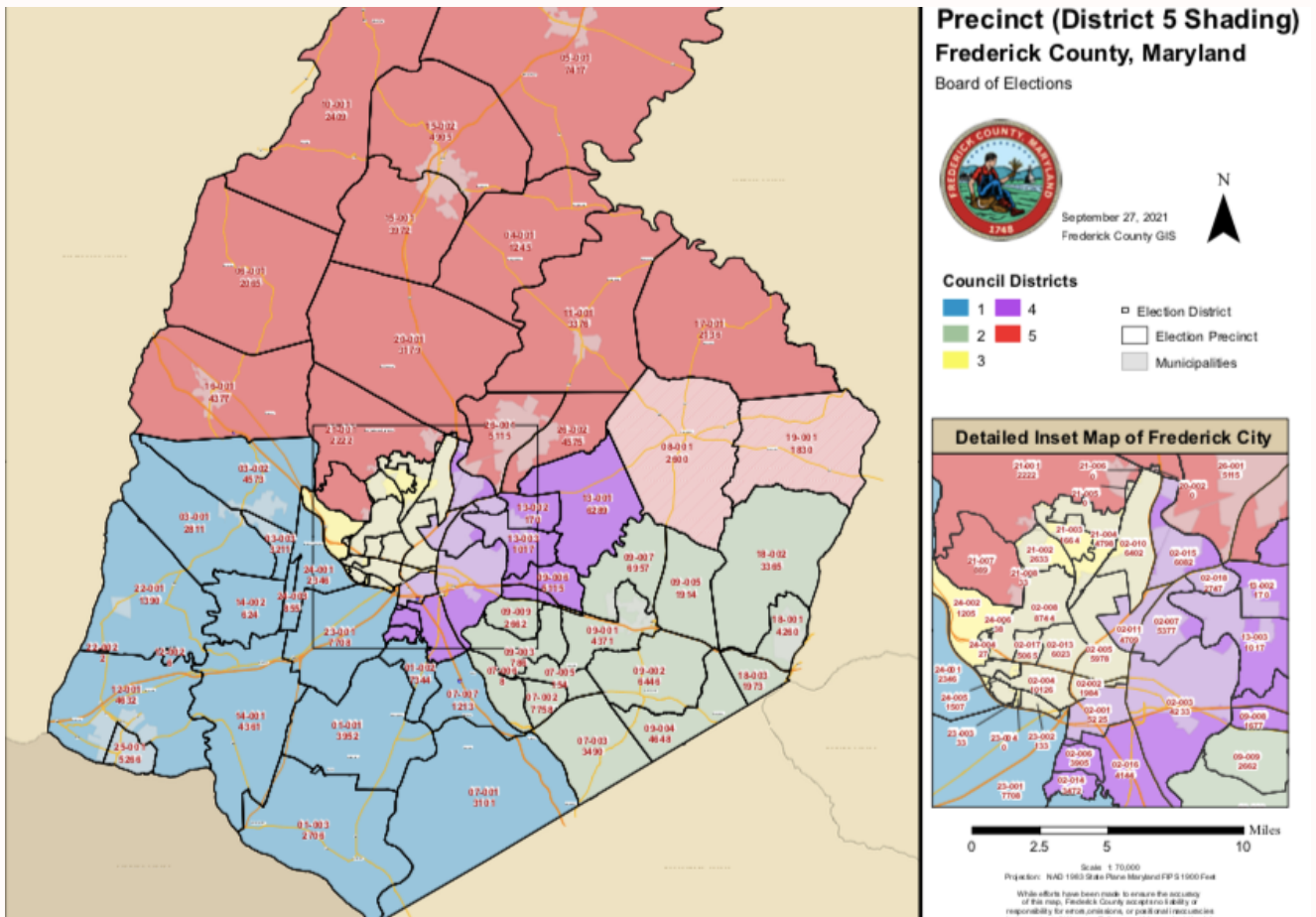
