Single-Family House Fire in Libertytown

FREDERICK, Md. (Jan. 28, 2022) – At approximately 12:41 p.m., today, Frederick County Division of Fire and Rescue units dispatched to a single-family house fire in the 12000 block of North Street in Libertytown, Maryland. Units arrived to find active fire from the rear of the residence and requested the Tanker Task Force and Rapid Intervention dispatch. Initial crews performed a primary search of the residence and discovered all occupants of the home were out of the structure. During the investigation and search crews found fire in the attic as well.

It took approximately 45 firefighters from Frederick and Carroll counties about 45 minutes to place the fire out. Crews and the Fire Marshal remain on the scene checking for extension, extinguishing hotspots, performing overhaul, and conducting their investigation. 2 adults were displaced and are being assisted by Red Cross. No civilian or firefighter injuries.
