1.	Describe the impact of this proposed legislation on your agency (operations, revenues, expenditures, etc). If there is no impact, <u>please explain why.</u>						
This legislation amends Chapter 1-6, Article II of the Frederick County Code (Building Code) to provide a building code exemption to allow farm owners to construct, use and occupy a structure that does not exceed 600 square feet for a farm stand. This bill does not require them to pull a County building permit. There are only a handful of these structures currently permitted each year so any lost revenue would be minimal to the County(estimate under \$1,000 annually)							
Please indicate whether the proposed legislation will affect small businesses in Frederick County, and if it will, please provide any information you may have which could be useful in determining the economic impact on small businesses.							
There would be a positive impact for farmers who sell home grown products. Since the exemption does not require them to pull a permit they will not need to pay an architect to prepare drawings and are not obligated to meet some of the building code requirements such as installing bathrooms and some accessibility measures. On a per application basis this could be anywhere from a few thousand dollars to over \$10,000 depending on the project scope.
