Should the Council Members pass any amendments that either delete more than 50% of any budget line item or decrease the total budget by 1% or greater, a second Budget Hearing will be scheduled on May 17.

**May 17:** Final Budget Adoption or Second Budget Hearing (if needed)

**May 24:** Amended Final Budget Adoption (if needed)
