Frederick County Government Services to Be Closed for Independence Day Holiday

FREDERICK, MD – Frederick County Government offices will be closed on Monday, July 4, 2022 in observance of the Independence Day holiday. Services will resume at their regularly scheduled times on Tuesday, July 5.

Additional information regarding the holiday schedule:

- **Animal Control:** Administrative offices and animal adoptions will be closed on Monday, July 4. Animal Control Officers will be on duty and may be reached at 301-600-1544. For animal related emergency situations, call 301-600-1603 or visit www.FrederickCountyMD.gov/animalcontrol.

- **Landfill and the Reichs Ford Road Recycling Center** : The facility will be closed on Monday, July 4, resulting in the residential recycling collection schedule shifting one day later than the normal for the entire week.
