## RECYCLING DROP-OFF CENTER

**9031 REICHS FORD ROAD, FREDERICK MD 21704**

Look for the large white sign just west of the main facility entrance. Open 7am to 4:30 pm, Monday through Saturday.

**Think outside the bin!** Your home recycle bin or cart is part of a single-stream recycling program that is only designed to collect and process a limited array of materials. But our recycling drop-off site offers a way to divert many other items from landfill disposal. It's easy to access and free to use. Items accepted for no charge include:

**Appliances:** "White goods" such as refrigerators, stoves, washing machines, air conditioners, hot water heaters, etc. (Not Accepted: small, mostly plastic appliances such as blenders, alarm clocks, etc.)

**Automotive Materials:** Motor oil (up to 5 gallons per day) and filters (no empty oil bottles), antifreeze, diesel fuel, hydraulic and transmission fluids, and lead-acid batteries.

**Bulky/Oversized Rigid Plastics:** The only accepted items are plastic crates, buckets, plastic furniture, storage tubs/totes, drum/barrels, water cooler bottles, plastic pallets, outdoor play sets, trash cans, laundry baskets. *No other large plastic items are accepted.*

**Flexible Foam:** Foam carpet padding, foam couch cushions, foam-only mattresses (no standard/spring mattresses).

**Scrap Metal:** Anything made of at least 75% metal, such as bicycles, fencing, lawn mowers, wire coat hangers, grills, swing sets, aluminum lawn chairs, barbeque grills, pots and pans, file cabinets, metal shelving, etc.

**Vegetable Oil:** Up to 5 gallons per resident per day can be dropped off. Your container will be left behind, so, please bring oil in something you are prepared to lose. No animal fats.

**Yard Waste:** Loose or paper-bagged leaves, grass clippings, garden debris, trimmings and branches less than 8' long and less than 8" in diameter.

Our facility also collects electronics and tires for recycling. However, these programs do incur a small fee for dropping off these materials. They may be brought to the main entrance of the facility for processing.
