14 there has been considerable growth and development in the Urbana area and along the I-270
15 corridor. Recognizing this, the Livable Frederick Master Plan Implementation Program (October
16 2019) in its Planning Area Catalogue described an elective plan for a larger, thematically-
17 conceived *Urbana Corridor* that could include a plan for the South Frederick Triangle, the
18 Urbana Community Growth Area, or the I-270 corridor. [~~The scale and scope of future planning
19 for the Urbana Community Growth Area or the I-270 corridor may determine the degree and
20 extent of examination of lands within the Sugarloaf Planning Area, if any, and may result in a
21 limited plan amendment to the Sugarloaf Treasured Landscape Management plan.~~] The South
22 Frederick Triangle has now been incorporated into the South Frederick Corridors Plan.
