<p><b>What is the overall <a href="#">deductible</a>?</b></p>	<p>For <a href="#">in-network providers</a>: \$0/individual or \$0/family                      For <a href="#">out-of-network providers</a>: \$300/individual or \$600/family</p>	<p>Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <a href="#">providers</a> up to the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount before this <a href="#">plan</a> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <a href="#">plan</a>, each family member must meet their own individual <a href="#">deductible</a> until the total amount of <a href="#">deductible</a> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family <a href="#">deductible</a>.</p>
<p><b>Are there services covered before you meet your <a href="#">deductible</a>?</b></p>	<p>Yes. Out-of-network preventive care &amp; immunizations, <a href="#">prescription drugs</a>, out-of-network emergency room visits, out-of-network <a href="#">urgent care</a> facility visits.</p>	<p>This <a href="#">plan</a> covers some items and services even if you haven't yet met the <a href="#">deductible</a> amount. Will you pay less if you use a <a href="#">network provider</a> ?	Yes. See <a href="http://www.cigna.com">www.cigna.com</a> or call 1-800-Cigna24 for a list of <a href="#">network providers</a> .	This <a href="#">plan</a> uses a <a href="#">provider network</a> . You will pay less if you use a <a href="#">provider</a> in the <a href="#">plan's network</a> . You will pay the most if you use an <a href="#">out-of-network provider</a> , and you might receive a bill from a <a href="#">provider</a> for the difference between the <a href="#">provider's</a> charge and what your <a href="#">plan</a> pays ( <a href="#">balance billing</a> ). Be aware your <a href="#">network provider</a> might use an <a href="#">out-of-network provider</a> for some services (such as lab work). Check with your <a href="#">provider</a> before you get services.
Do you need a <a href="#">referral</a> to see a <a href="#">specialist</a> ?	No.	You can see the <a href="#">specialist</a> you choose without a <a href="#">referral</a> .

### **Does this plan provide Minimum Essential Coverage? Yes**
