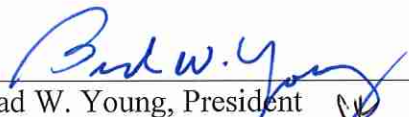

ARTICLE III: RESERVED [ADMISSIONS AND AMUSEMENT TAX] (§§ 1-8-46 – 1-8-47)

§ 1-8-46. RESERVED [LEVY; AMOUNT.]

A tax is hereby imposed on the gross receipts derived from any admissions and amusement charge as defined in Md. Code Ann., Tax-General Article, § 4-101(b), as amended or recodified from time to time, at the rate of 0%; except that the tax imposed on gross receipts derived from charges for merchandise, refreshments, or a service sold or served in connection with entertainment at a nightclub or room in a hotel, restaurant, hall, or other place where dancing privileges, music, or other entertainment is provided shall be at the rate of 0%.]

§ 1-8-47. RESERVED [TAX ON REDUCED CHARGE OR FREE ADMISSION.]

No tax is hereby imposed on reduced charges or free admissions permitted by Md. Code Ann., Tax-General Article, § 4-102, as amended or recodified from time to time.]
