CHAPTER 1-8: LIGHTING DISTRICTS

4 § 1-8-104. ELECTRIC LIGHTING DISTRICT TAX RATES.

5 (A) A special district tax shall be levied on all assessable real property within the established
6 electric lighting districts as follows.

7 (1) Braddock Heights: \$[0.010] 0.013 per \$100 of assessed value.

8 (2) Libertytown: \$[0.010] 0.014 per \$100 of assessed value.

9 (3) New Addition: \$[0.010] 0.014 per \$100 of assessed value.

10 (B) The tax rates established shall continue in effect each year hereafter until changed by the
11 county governing body.
