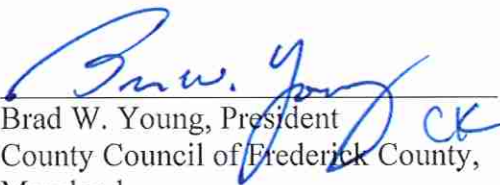

CHAPTER 1-8: LIGHTING DISTRICTS

§ 1-8-104. ELECTRIC LIGHTING DISTRICT TAX RATES.

(A) A special district tax shall be levied on all assessable real property within the established electric lighting districts as follows.

(1) Braddock Heights: \$[0.010] 0.013 per \$100 of assessed value.

(2) Libertytown: \$[0.010] 0.014 per \$100 of assessed value.

(3) New Addition: \$[0.010] 0.014 per \$100 of assessed value.

(B) The tax rates established shall continue in effect each year hereafter until changed by the county governing body.

[Single boldface brackets] indicates matter deleted from existing law.

*** - indicates existing law unaffected by bill.

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
