FREDERICK, Md. – The Transportation Association of Maryland (TAM) recognized Transit Services of Frederick County with two major awards at their 2024 Annual Conference – **Outstanding Transit System Achievement Award** and **Outstanding Transit Employee Award**.

Transit Services was recognized for the organization’s efforts to significantly expand and improve service. Major achievements include expanding rural transit and adding Saturday service, implementing more effective administrative techniques, improving communications and marketing, and collaborating with riders, staff, and community partners to enhance the rider experience.
