## **Frederick County Treasury and Permitting Lobby to Reopen Tuesday, January 20** *Reopening Comes After Renovations to the Building*

FREDERICK, Md. – The Frederick County Division of Planning and Permitting and the Treasury Department will reopen 30 North Market Street to walk-in traffic on Tuesday, January 20 following the completion of security renovations in the building's lobby.

This County-funded project was undertaken to enhance safety and security for both staff and members of the community. The renovations are part of Frederick County's ongoing commitment to providing a safe and welcoming environment for those conducting business at County facilities.

In addition to the physical improvements, a new visitor management system has been implemented to support a more secure and efficient check-in process for all visitors.
