

How to Purchase your Knox Product:

All Knox products can be purchased on line by going to www.knoxbox.com. Follow these simple steps to complete your purchase.

1. Select Online Purchase and choose the product you wish to purchase
 - a. Knox Box 3200 Series.
 - b. Knox Vaults 4400 Series.
 - c. Recessed Mounting Kits (RMK)
 - d. Pad Locks
2. Since all zip codes in Frederick County begin with 217 your choices are going to be Hagerstown Fire Department, Halfway Vol. Fire Co., or Frederick County Department of Fire and Rescue.
3. When prompted to enter your Zip Code enter 21702.
4. Select "**Frederick County Department of Fire/Rescue**" from the list for any product being purchased for use in Frederick County, Maryland.
5. Select **BUY NOW** and choose the option of **Hinged Door under** "Door Type".
6. Select any other options you choose and then complete the remaining information requested.
7. For Padlocks select either the Knox Padlock Model 3770-Exterior All Weather Conditions, or Model 3772-Exterior All Weather Conditions Shrouded.
8. Once your box has been installed and you have scheduled your final inspection, label your keys with a permanent label and an inspector will secure your keys in your Knox Box during your final inspection.

Where to install your Knox Box: Knox Boxes are usually installed at the main entrance of a structure or at the point where Fire/Rescue units will enter your property. When mounting your Knox Box on a wall install the Knox Box no higher than six (6) feet from the finished grade surface.

Once your box has been installed and you have scheduled your final inspection, label your keys with a permanent label and an inspector will secure your keys in your Knox Box during your final inspection.

Code Requirements:

The State of Maryland Fire Prevention Code (COMAR 29.06.08) has adopted the National Fire Protection Associations, NFPA-1, Fire Code as the State standard.

Frederick County uses the State standard as its reference. The Uniform Fire Code states under sections 18.2.2.1 and 18.2.2.2 that the Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ), the Frederick County Fire Marshal has the authority to require an access box (es) to be installed in an accessible location to permit access to or with in a structure or areas to include gated subdivisions and developments that are deemed difficult.
