If continuation of the process is necessary, the Board of Canvassers will announce its schedule at the end of the day, and, if necessary, at the end of each subsequent day.

A second canvass of timely absentee ballots will begin at 10 a.m. on Friday, November 14. It is anticipated that the processing and counting of these ballots will be completed on this date.
